Directions to the Northwest Louisiana Veterans Cemetery

North on I-49 from Natchitoches

Take Exit 186 (Kingston-Frierson/La 175); turn left and go approximately one mile to intersection of LA 5; turn right and proceed approximately 15 miles to stop sign in Keatchie; turn right on LA 789 and go approximately six miles to just past prison at intersection of Mike Clark Road; turn left into Eddie D. Jones Nature Park on Mike Clark Road; go approximately one-half mile; Northwest Louisiana Veterans Cemetery is on right

South on I-49 from Shreveport

Take Exit on LA 3132 (Inner Loop Expressway) and bear right (West toward Dallas) then continue to Walker Road exit; turn left and go to end of Walker Road at intersection with Colquitt Road (LA 525); turn right and go approximately 13 miles to four-way stop at intersection of LA 169 in Spring Ridge; turn left and go one mile to intersection of LA 789; bear left on LA 789 and continue for approximately two and a half miles to white church on right at intersection of Mike Clark Road; turn right into Eddie D. Jones Nature Park on Mike Clark Road and go approximately one-half mile; Northwest Louisiana Veterans Cemetery is on right

East on I-20 from Texas

Take Exit 3 (US 79/Carthage) to first traffic signal at intersection of US 80; turn left and to first blinking signal at intersection of LA 169; turn right and go approximately 10 miles to second fourway stop in Spring Ridge; continue on LA 169 for one mile to intersection of LA 789; bear left on LA 789 and continue for approximately two and a half miles; look for sign to Northwest Louisiana Veterans Cemetery

West on I-20 from Shreveport

Take Exit 8 (Bert Kouns Industrial Loop/LA 526); go south on Bert Kouns to traffic signal at intersection of Woolworth Road (fire station); turn right and continue to end of road at intersection of LA 525/Colquitt Road; turn right and continue to four-way stop at intersection of LA 169 in Spring Ridge; turn left and go one mile to intersection of LA 789; bear left on LA 789 and continue for approximately two and a half miles; look for sign to Northwest Louisiana Veterans Cemetery
