



About Our Home

The Northeast Louisiana Veterans Home is a 156-bed facility located on a 20-acre pecan orchard backing up to Bayou Desiard in Monroe, La.

The home holds a library, an activities room and a chapel. Residents have access to a variety of books, magazines, CDs, puzzles and movies in the library. There are also computers and a printer for resident use.

In the activities room, residents can enjoy leather working, painting, latch hook and building model cars, airplanes and more. Larger group activities include exercise, bingo, pet therapy and outings organized by our Activities Department staff. We also have an interactive computer system, It's Never 2 Late, for individual and group activities. Our chapel, with its beautiful stained glass windows, is a quiet place for meditation or attending a worship service.

Outdoors, there is a gazebo and fishing pier on the bayou. There are multiple covered patios for loved ones to share a picnic lunch as well as a garden for those with a green thumb.

What We Provide

- short and long-term care
- 24-hour nursing care in a secure environment
- dedicated, tenured staff
- three hot meals and snacks daily with accommodations for special dietary needs
- rehabilitation services including physical, occupational and speech therapy
- psychiatric counseling to help reduce PTSD and make adjustments to congregate living
- medication management
- individualized care planning to increase independence
- Medicare-certified beds for skilled nursing facility care
- cognitive impairment unit for Alzheimer's disease or dementia-related diagnoses
- dynamic activity program with a wide variety of entertainment, games and travel
- on-site barber and beauty salon

Our Fees

- There is no monthly fee for veterans with a service-connected disability rating between 70-100%.
- Veterans approved after admission for Pension with Aid and Attendance* may be eligible to receive the monthly Care and Maintenance fee** from the federal VA for payment to the home.
- Veterans' spouses and Gold Star parents are eligible for admission with a monthly fee of \$4,500.***

*A veteran is not eligible for Pension with Aid and Attendance unless he/she served in a wartime era.

**The monthly Care and Maintenance fee is set by the federal VA and changes periodically.

***All fees subject to change.
